#### ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Bishop Remigius School is administered by a Christian minority society namely the R. C. Diocese of Kottar, Nagercoil, Tamilnadu. This school was started as a souvenir of the Episcopal Silver Jubilee of Most Rev. Dr. Peter Remigius, Bishop of Kottar. This school is giving education to the students belonging to all religions especially, the students of Christian Minority. Bishop of Kottar Diocese is the chairman of the school. Though we are administering many government aided schools and self-financing schools, we do not have any CBSE school in this locality. This is the first CBSE school started by the R. C. Diocese of Kottar.

This school is situated in the heart of Nagercoil Town, the capital of Kanyakumari District. There has been a repeated demand from the people that we should have a CBSE School in this locality. Though there are people working in Central Government organisations, it is very important to note that people having Central Government jobs are very less. To get in to premier institutes such as IIT, IIM, NIT, AIIMS or into any other Higher Educational Institutions belonging to Central Government, we need a central school to fulfil the aspiration of the people living in this locality. As the world is becoming more and more competitive in nature, we need to prepare the students for facing today's challenges. For this purpose we have started this Senior Secondary School which is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi.

#### THE SCHOOL SYSTEM

**The Prefectorial System**: The school is divided into various houses that depict the true Indian ethics. There will be an investiture ceremony held at the beginning of every year to honour the captains and vice captains of the houses.

**The Mentor System**: The school appoints academic mentors who are always there to see to each individual's continuous development and growth. There is also a counselor to guide each student.

**The Leadership System**: Students are exposed to various club activities such as the International award for young people, Interact club, National Green corps, Scout & Guides programme etc. Leadership qualities are developed through these club activities.

**The Pedagogy System**: Our academic faculty is chosen from amongst the best in the academic qualification with an impeccable academic record. The school follows the best pedagogical system.

**Parent Teacher's Meeting**: Parents can have periodical meeting with the teachers, coordinators and the principal to know about their child's continuous comprehensive evaluation and progress. These meetings are arranged soon after the exams. These activities are strengthened through Parent Teacher Association.

**School Management Committee**: The School Management Committee is formed in our school according to the stipulations laid down by the RTE Act 2009. Bishop of Kottar Diocese is the Chairman of the School Management Committee.









#### SKILL DEVELOPMENT

# **Linguistic Development:**

To develop the students' communication skills and increase their command of language. This is developed through English and at least two additional languages.

# **Mathematical Development:**

To teach students how to calculate and appreciate relationships in number and space as well as to think logically and express themselves clearly. This is developed through Mathematics.

## **Social Development:**

To teach students about people and their interaction with the environment and how human action has influenced events and conditions. This is developed through Social Studies.

## **Physical Development:**

To teach the basic principles of fitness and health and to develop students' physical control and coordination. This is developed through Games and Physical Education.

## **Creative Development:**

To develop the students' aesthetic and creative skills. This is developed through Art, Drama and Music.

## **Spiritual Development:**

To develop the students' self-knowledge, self-esteem and self-confidence so that they can contribute to community life. This is developed through Catechism and Moral Studies.

The Junior Red Cross is the Students's wing of the Red Cross. It is a group movement organized within schools.

## **INFRASTRUCTURE & FACILITIES**

**School Building** is nested in the picturesque landscape. The school is situated in 3 acres of land having a large play ground.

**Classrooms**: Well equipped, well lit, well ventilated and spacious classrooms provide the learner a comfortable and homely ambience.

**Laboratories**: The specially designed computer center, the science labs, the Maths lab, Computer lab, Language lab, Social Studies Lab etc., enhance on learning.

**The Smart E-Classes**: A novel & practical method of learning subjects through latest technology is in place. Intel Teach Program is followed in our school.

**Library**: Well stocked library specially designed for the junior and senior classes. There are more than 5,500 books, periodicals, journals and newspapers etc.

**Art and Craft Room**: Children are exposed to create something new of their own. It helps them to identify their artistic inclination.

**Sports and Games:** The school has a spacious play ground and indoor game rooms to train students in football, volleyball, basketball, shuttle, kho-kho, table tennis, chess and carroms.

**Multipurpose Hall:** There is an aesthetically designed Multi Purpose Hall for conducting dance classes, hosting cultural programmes and training in fine arts and other co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.











#### ADMISSION PROCESS

Our academic session begins in the month of April and ends in March. The school prospectus along with the application form can be obtained from the school reception in the month of January on payment of Rs.200. Admission will be confirmed only after assessing the child and a personal interview with the head of the school. It is necessary to produce all relevant documents such as Aadhar Card, Birth Certificate, Transfer Certificate and Community Certificate. In pre primary the children will be assessed on the basis of their interaction with the head and the following age criteria:

Pre-KG – between 2.5 and 3.0 years

LKG – between 3.0 and 4.0 years

UKG – between 4.0 and 4.5 years

Std XI - As per the CBSE norms
